Date restoration commenced	System	Head	Death
A.D. 554	1. Imperial Restoration	Justinian	Died of natural causes in 565
A.D. 774	2. Frankish Kingdom (Carolingian Empire)	Charlemagne (Karl der Grosse – known as "Father of Europe" (<i>pater Europae</i>))	Died in 814 of fever and pleurisy
A.D. 962	3. German Kingdom	Otto the Great	Died of natural causes in 973 (NB Frederick of Barbarossa was also a very significant head. He died from drowning in 1190)
A.D. 1530	4. Habsburg Dynasty	Charles V	Died of natural causes in 1558
A.D. 1804	5. French domination (& Confederation of the Rhine which members were princes of the old Holy Roman Empire)	Napoleon	Died on St Helena's island in exile of stomach cancer in 1821

A.D. 1870-1945	6. German-Italian axis & East European allies	Bismark & Garibaldi; Wilhelm II; culminating with Hitler & Mussolini	<p>Bismark died in 1898 of natural causes; Garibaldi died 1882 of natural causes; Wilhelm II died of natural causes in exile in the Netherlands in 1941</p> <p>Mussolini killed by partisans. Hitler's death and whereabouts unknown – he may have shot himself and been cremated or escaped to South America</p>
A.D. 2???	7. Probably emerge out of the European Union with Germany dominating	Unknown	Lake of fire (Rev 20:10)
A.D.	Satan		Imprisoned in the abyss for 1,000 years (Rev 20:1-3)
